

End User License Agreement (“EULA”) on the rugby sevens (R7) tracking dataset.

The Commissariat à l’Energie Atomique et aux Energies Alternatives (CEA) holds author rights and neighbouring rights pursuant to the French Intellectual Property Code on the R7 tracking database, which you are about to use.

The videos in the R7 tracking dataset are the courtesy of World Rugby and annotations are provided by CEA.

If YOU do ACCEPT this EULA, YOU will be allowed to copy, duplicate, represent and adapt (including through data digitization or compression, cropping, rescaling...) the whole or parts of the images or pictures provided by the R7 tracking dataset, ONLY FOR (i) Research and Development (R&D) activities [as YOU will describe them below] focusing on video data analysis, (ii) publication of YOUR described Research results subject to the condition that FACES ARE BLURRED in said publication, whether the publication support is paper or digital, EXCLUDING ANY COMMERCIAL USE.

In particular, YOU are NOT allowed to duplicate and distribute the whole or parts of images and pictures to third parties, no matter of the physical mean.

If one Person involved and represented in the R7 tracking dataset (in one or several images or pictures) does not want to be represented in the R7 tracking dataset any longer, CEA will keep YOU informed, and YOU will have to remove immediately the images and pictures where this Person is represented in YOUR R&D data and tasks.

Any Communication or Publication on Research work having involved parts of / or the whole R7 tracking dataset data will have to provide QUOTATION of (at least) the following initial publication/announcement of the R7 tracking dataset:
